

## HR-218 SUNRISE RETIREE SHOOT CHIEF OF POLICE ANTHONY W. ROSA

On Wednesday September 5<sup>th</sup> from 9:00 am to 1:00 pm, the City of Sunrise Police Department will be hosting firearms qualifications for its Police Retirees with a luncheon to follow.

The City of Sunrise Police Department will only provide the following ammunition for qualification: 380 cal., 9mm, and 40 cal.

- \* Only 380 cal., 9mm, and 40 cal. ammunition will be provided for qualification.
- \* Retirees will be responsible to bring all other ammunition not previously specified.
- \* No armor piercing, frangible, or reloads are permitted.
- \* Qualification course is a 40 round FDLE Course.
- \* A maximum of 2 firearms per shooter.
- \* No one will be permitted to enter into the police department with a loaded firearm.
- \* All firearms will be brought to the department in a closed case and shall be inspected by Sunrise Police Range personnel.
- \* Retirees will check in at the front desk and will wait in the lobby for range personnel.
- \* Only qualified Sunrise Police Retirees will be permitted to shoot.
- \* Retirees' status will be checked via FDLE and FCIC/NCIC to confirm their eligibility.
